## *About Your Plan Purchase and V.P.P. Disclaimers*

This document certifies all V.P.P.'s protection plans (herein called "V.P.P.") and warranties and acts as your certificate. No other documentation will be issued. It is advised that you keep your copy of this certificate for your records and for reference when making appointments. No repairs will be made without this certificate.

Vehicle Protection Plans may be passed on to a second owner or lessee of the vehicle within 15 days of the sale of the vehicle for a fee payable to V.P.P. Inc. of \$30 plus GST which covers the transfer of ownership fees, plus dealer fees if applicable.

V.P.P. is not an insurance product but an alternative for minor repairs to your vehicle. Any and all major repairs must be done at a body shop of the owner's choice.

V.P.P. covers V.P.P. repairs that the lessee may be charged for when he/she is returning the vehicle.

Some restrictions apply on various repairs. Any previous damage to any pre-owned vehicles that qualify for V.P.P. will not be covered under this plan.

Excessive damage is not covered. V.P.P. does not replace broken parts. V.P.P. does have limitations on the usage of its plans and prohibits excessive abuse by individuals of these plans as determined by V.P.P. in its sole discretion. V.P.P. reserves the right to deny repairs to individuals who do abuse the usage of these plans at V.P.P.'s manager's sole discretion.

All plans and warranties do not include major body work or accidents; severe accidental damage to your vehicle is not covered by V.P.P. In these situations you should file a claim with your insurance provider.

V.P.P. retains the right in its sole discretion to determine if damage is considered a major repair damage covered by this plan or misuse.

Paintless dent repairs Most minor dents are easily removed, however some PDR cannot be repaired due to their limited accessibility on the back of the dent. It is in these cases that a body shop repair may be required at the plan holder's expense.

Bumper Repairs These small tears and scuffs can be easily repaired with the aid of our advanced technology retaining that look like new appearance in just a fraction of time. There are some instances in which a bumper may require new parts or require major paint repairs and in these cases it will be necessary that the owner have it repaired at a body shop at his or her cost.

Paint Chips Any minor chips and scratches can be easily repaired. If Paint Chips are not properly treated early enough more severe damage may occur such as rust bubbles or paint peeling at the initial site of the damage. The V.P.P. does not cover this damage which must be restored by a body shop at the owner's cost.
